Quarantine – Property Assessment

St Helena Government has taken the measure to quarantine all individuals arriving to the island for 14 days, due to the global COVID-19 pandemic.

The purpose of this questionnaire is to enable proper officers to establish if the property you propose to quarantine in on St Helena is suitable.

You may propose your own home, a property which friends or family are willing to loan to you at your own expense or a property you are willing to rent privately at your own expense.

(All information provided will be treated as confidential and will only be viewed by staff in the Health Directorate and SHG employees who are bound by confidentiality)

Any property that you intend to quarantine in on St. Helena must be un-occupied.

Please note: If at any time during the quarantine period at home you develop symptoms consistent with Covid-19 you will be transferred to the medical treatment facilities at Bradley's Camp for monitoring and treatment.
