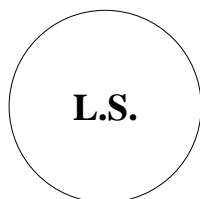

ST HELENA

**PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939*****PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES)
(CORONAVIRUS NO. 2)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2021***

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 49 of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

Citation and interpretation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2)(Amendment) Regulations, 2021.

Isolation upon entry

2. Regulation 4 of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, is amended—

(a) by revoking sub-regulation (1) and substituting:

“(1) A person who arrives in St Helena by air, must upon entry stay in isolation for a period of 14 days at such location as directed by a proper officer.”;

(b) by deleting paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (2) and substituting:

“(b) if a proper officer is satisfied that it is not possible or practical for the person to remain aboard the vessel for the full period as required by paragraph (a), must isolate at such location as directed by the proper officer for that period or remainder of that period.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, to remove the prescribed location for isolation under the Regulations and make provision for the proper officer to direct where a person must remain in isolation.
