

AN ORDINANCE

to increase the amounts provided for the services of the financial year 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Second Supplementary Appropriation (2020/21) Ordinance, 2021.

Consolidated Fund—provision for the financial year 2020/2021

2. The Governor may cause to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund and applied to the services of the financial year commencing on 1st April, 2020, a sum not exceeding £749,000 (Seven Hundred and Forty Nine Thousand pounds), which is appropriated for the purposes and services described in Schedule I and II to this Ordinance.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

This Ordinance increases the 2020/21 budgets approved by Legislative Council in June 2020 for the respective directorate expenditure based on the latest available forecast.

The amount in question will be financed by withdrawals from Head 13: Corporate Services - Corporate Human Resources of £80,000, Head 17: Corporate Services - Corporate Finance of £450,000, Head 21: Access of £100,000, and Head 26: Environment and Natural Resources of £8,000 resulting from projected under spends within recurrent expenditure budgets; and additional revenues generated under Head 27: Infrastructure and Transport of £61,000 and Head 17: Corporate Services - Corporate Finance of £50,000.
