PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

NOTICE PROHIBITING THE IMPORTATION AND LANDING OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS ORIGINATING FROM SOUTH AFRICA

As a consequence of the outbreak of avian influenza in South Africa and to prevent the introduction of the disease into St Helena, pursuant to section 55(1) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, the importation and landing of the following products originating, produced or packaged in South Africa is prohibited with effect from 13 July 2021—

- (a) all birds eggs whether with or without the shell;
- (b) all raw meat of all bird species; and
- (c) all raw offal from all bird species,

and take notice that pursuant to section 55(2) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, any person who contravenes this notice commits an offence and is liable to prosecution.
