**NOTES:**

1. *It is unlawful for any person to enter or remain in St. Helena unless he or she holds a valid short term or long term entry permit or is exempt from the requirement to hold either of these permits. A person who is the dependant of a person who holds St. Helenian status is exempt from the requirement to hold an entry permit.*

2. *A dependant, in relation to a person; means –*

*(a) The spouse or life partner of that person; and*

*(b) The child, step-child or adopted child of that person, who is under the age of 18 years or who is over that age and –*

*(i) Is in full time education; and*

*(ii) Is under the age of 25*

3. *Spouses and life partners of a person who has St. Helenian status may work in St. Helena without a separate authorisation.*

4. *It is a criminal offence to give false information*
