



# St Helena Home Quarantine Quarantine Bubbles



## What is required of arriving passengers?

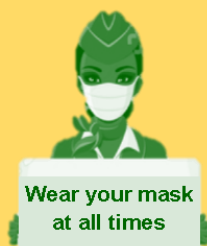
Passengers arriving to St Helena are required to complete a pre-arrival questionnaire to notify Proper Officers on-Island of their intention to enter mandatory quarantine with another person/s.

All persons must provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result taken at least 72 hrs prior to departure.

**COVID-19 Free**



All persons must follow social distancing and hygiene requirements on-board the flight.



All persons are required to have a further COVID-19 test on arrival. If a person tests positive for COVID-19 on arrival, if they are asymptomatic or have mild symptoms, they will remain in quarantine at home or at Bradley's. Only serious cases of COVID-19 will be treated at Bradley's Hospital.

Arriving passengers have opted to Home Quarantine since January 2021.



Quarantine Bubble arrangements allow persons arriving to St Helena to have persons join them at the same property for the mandatory quarantine period.

The person/s joining quarantine could be those who are travelling to St Helena at the same time or persons who were already on-Island.



Persons who choose to enter the Quarantine Bubble voluntarily, must understand that they do so at their own risk



Quarantine can only take place at properties approved by the Proper Officers



Persons on-Island must make the necessary work/leave arrangements and have their employers approval for the entire quarantine period, no financial or absence claims can be reclaimed from their employer



Quarantine Bubbles have proven to provide support during a quarantine period. It also reduces additional costs for an individual's travel to St Helena.



All persons in quarantine, including those joining arriving passengers, must comply with all quarantine rules. The quarantine period is only deemed to be complete if they test negative for COVID-19 on the final day of quarantine.
