Development Proposal for Satellite Earth Stations at Horse Point

The Planning Service has received the development application for the development of 19 Satellite Earth Stations and Control Building at Horse Point and is now seeking the views of the communities and businesses and all other interested parties. This is now a formal stage of the development process to assist with the assessment and its potential impact.

The consultation meetings are now your opportunity to view the details of the proposal and to let the Land Development Control Authority know of your concerns and support for the proposal.
