PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

EXEMPTION FROM ISOLATION

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts JEFFREY JOHNSON, KAREN JOHNSON and ALAINA JOHNSON from the requirement to remain at the location directed by the proper officer for isolation under regulation 4(1) on compassionate grounds to enable them to visit an individual in the hospital.

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that they must remain at the location where they were directed to isolate by the proper officer, save when making such visits, and at all times comply with all other requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
