### PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939 PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

## **EXEMPTION FROM ISOLATION**

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts the following persons from the requirement to remain at the location directed by the proper officer for isolation under regulation 4(1) on compassionate grounds to enable them to view the remains of their family member at the hospital mortuary:

DENIS BRUNETON CATHERINE BRUNETON MARTIN BRUNETON DOMITILLE BRUNETON

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that they must remain at the location where they were directed to isolate by the proper officer, save when making such visit, and at all times comply with all other requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.

# PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts Dr Paschalis Gavriilidis and Dr Francisco Reyes Milian who are currently in isolation under regulation 4(1), from the requirement to isolate for such period or periods as required by them to provide urgent medical assistance and treatment to two patients identified by the Director of Health.

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that they must remain at the location where they were directed to isolate by the proper officer, save when providing such medical assistance and treatment, and must at all times comply with all other requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
