CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE, 1999

CUSTOMS DUTY (DIESEL FUEL) EXEMPTION ORDER, 2022

In exercise of the power conferred by paragraph 11(3) of the Second Schedule to the Customs (Tariffs and Exemptions) Regulations, 2011, the Governor in Council makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duty (Diesel Fuel) Exemption Order, 2022.

Exemption from customs duties

2. No customs duties are payable on any diesel fuel imported and sold—
 - (a) for the purpose of generating electricity by Connect St Helena Ltd;
 - (b) for use in commercial fishing;
 - (c) for use in running the fisheries processing plant.

Duration of Order

3. This Order applies with effect from 1 April 2022 up to and including 31 March 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order grants further exemption from customs duties of all diesel fuel used by Connect St Helena Ltd for purposes of generating electricity and also diesel fuel used for commercial fishing or running of the fisheries processing plant. These exemptions apply for one year with effect from 1 April 2022.
