PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

EXEMPTION FROM ISOLATION

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts Dr Katherine Tambudze, Werno Van Vollenhoven and Francois Van Den Burg, neonatal medical staff, who are expected to arrive in St Helena on or around 22 May 2022 to undertake immediate assessment of a premature baby and support the safe transition from St Helena Hospital to Johannesburg, from the requirement to remain in isolation for the full period of isolation as required by regulation 4(1).

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that, save when performing such services, they must remain at the location where they are directed to isolate by the proper officer and must at all times comply with all other requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health until their departure from St Helena.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
