PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

EXEMPTION FROM ISOLATION

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts Ronald Vhushavhelo Maposa, an engineer with Siemens Healthineers, who is expected to arrive in St Helena on or around 18 June 2022 to complete the repair and maintenance work on the scanners within the radiology department of the hospital, from the requirement to remain in isolation for the full period of isolation as required by regulation 4(1).

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that he must at all times comply with the requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health and, save when performing such work, must remain at the location where he was directed to isolate by the proper officer until his departure from St Helena.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
