FOR

AN ORDINANCE

to amend the Legislative Council (Remuneration and Allowances) Ordinance, 2010, to adjust the remuneration, allowances and benefits of Members of the Legislative Council, the Speaker, and Deputy Speaker.

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

Short title and commencement

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Legislative Council (Remuneration and Allowances) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021.
- (2) The Ordinance comes into force on 13 October 2021 and applies, in the case of—
 - (a) the Speaker and Deputy Speaker, with effect from the date elected as provided in section 55;
 - (b) any Elected Member of the Legislative Council, with effect from the date elected as Member of the Council;
 - (c) the Chief Minister, with effect from the date elected to that office in accordance with section 37; and
 - (d) any Minister, with effect from the date recommended as such by the Chief Minister in accordance with section 37A(1) or 37D.

Amendment of section 2 – Interpretation

2. Section 2 of the Legislative Council (Remuneration and Allowances) Ordinance, 2010, is amended by deleting the definitions of “Chairman” and “Executive Member”.

Amendment of Schedule 1 – Remuneration of Members

3. Schedule 1 to the Legislative Council (Remuneration and Allowances) Ordinance, 2010, is amended by deleting the table and substituting the following:
