PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939 PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

EXEMPTION FROM ISOLATION

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts, Elize Bellairs and Elvis Ndlovu, two healthcare workers, and Michele Taylor, a carer of a person in isolation, who arrived in St Helena on 16th July 2022, from the requirement to remain in isolation for such period or periods as may be required by them to perform medical and care duties as directed by the Director of Health.

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that, save when performing such duties, they must remain at the location where they are directed to isolate by the proper officer and must at all times comply with all other requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
