PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

EXEMPTION FROM ISOLATION

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts Maxime La Maillot, an engineer with Enviroearth who arrived in St Helena on July 30th 2022, from the requirement to remain in isolation for such period or periods as required by him to perform critical maintenance and repair work to scientific equipment at the Radionuclide Station, Bottom Woods, St Helena.

This exemption is granted subject to the condition that, save when performing such work, he must remain at the location where he was directed to isolate by the proper officer and must at all times comply with all other requirements as directed by the proper officer or the Director of Health.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
