BURIAL GROUNDS ORDINANCE, 1895

PROCLAMATION

In the Name of Her Majesty Elizabeth II, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

WHEREAS it is provided in section 2 of the Burial Grounds Ordinance, 1895, that the Governor in Council may at any time by Proclamation declare any Crown land, and, with the consent of the owner, any private land to be a cemetery.

AND WHEREAS it is required that burial space be made available for the reburial of the unearthed remains of the Liberated Africans.

NOW THEREFORE I, Nigel Phillips, Governor of St Helena, in consultation with the Executive Council and acting in accordance with section 2 of the Burial Grounds Ordinance, 1895, declare Parcel 51 of the Rupert's Valley Registration Section to be a cemetery, to be known as the Liberated African Cemetery, for the purpose of reburial or reinternment of unearthed Liberated African human remains.

GIVEN under my hand and the public Seal of St Helena at the Castle, Jamestown this 19th day of August 2022.
