PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

NOTIFIABLE INFECTIOUS DISEASES (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 32(1) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, the Governor in Council makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Notifiable Infectious Diseases (Amendment) Order, 2022, and comes into force on 8 August 2022.

Amendment of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Notifiable Infectious Diseases Order, 2009 is amended by deleting the following diseases from the list:

“Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19 or 2019-nCoV)
Acute Respiratory Disease ((2019-nCoV ARD)
Novel Coronavirus Pneumonia (NCP)
All known viral respiratory diseases caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the Notifiable Infectious Diseases Order, 2009 to remove the diseases related to coronavirus from the list of infectious diseases with effect from 8 August 2022, following the revocation of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020 with effect from that date.
