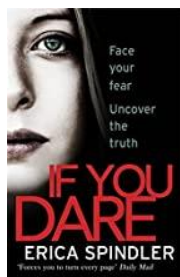

Freddie Lloyd has served time for murder and now he wants her back. Wherever she is, he won't stop until he finds her. Will he be able to track her to the ends of the earth?



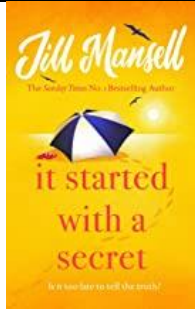
The Secrets She Keeps by Michael Robotham

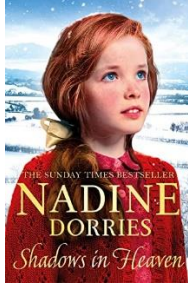
The Greek Escape by Karen Swan

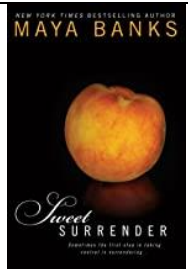


Shadows in Heaven by Nadine Dorries

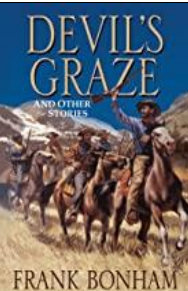

Sweet Surrender by Maya Banks

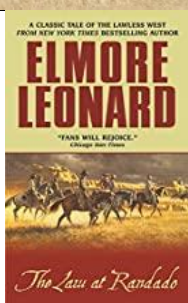
Under Faith Malone's soft exterior lies a woman who knows what she wants: A man who'll take without asking because she's willing to give him everything.

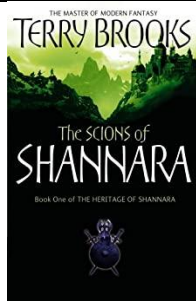
Devil's Graze and Other Stories by Frank Bonham

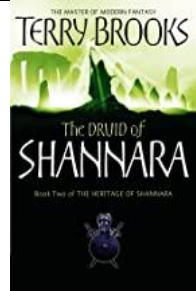
The Law at Randado by Elmore Leonard

The Scions of Shannara by Terry Brooks (Book 1)

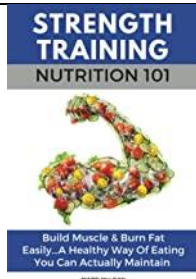

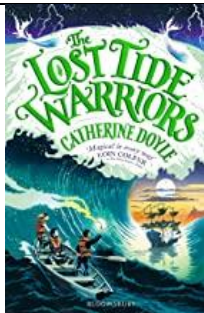


The Killer Cat by Paul Hutchens
