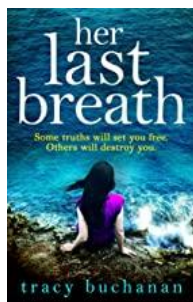

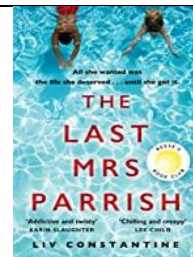


Her Last Breath by Tracy Buchanan

Estelle knows she must do everything to find Poppy. But how far will she go to hide the truth – that her perfect life was the perfect lie?

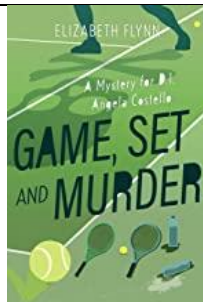


The Last Mrs Parrish by Liv Constantine

How far would you go to make all your dreams come true?



Amber Patterson is tired of being a nobody, an invisible woman who melts into the background. She deserves more. She deserves a life of wealth, luxury and leisure.

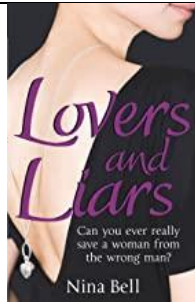

Game, Set and Murder by Elizabeth Flynn

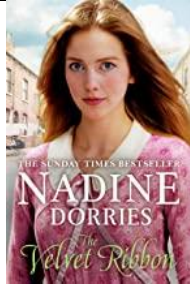

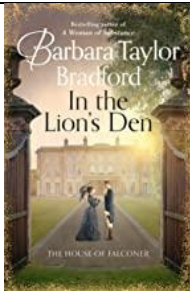
Lovers and Liars by Nina Bell

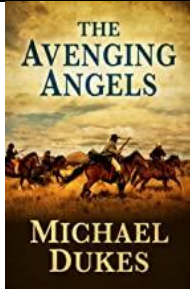
In the Lion's Den by Barbara Taylor Bradford

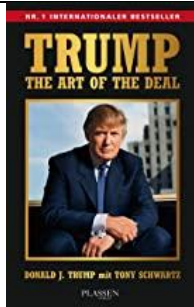
The Missing McCullen by Rita Herron

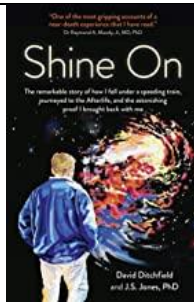


Trump The Art of the Deal by Donald Trump

Beastly Bugs by Kingfisher Books

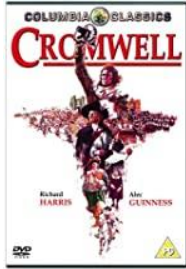

But also think of it as the tip of the wave of the 1980s nostalgia craze that followed on the heels of the 1970s nostalgia craze. Set in the post-disco, new wave era, the film tells the story of Robbie Hart, the king of small-town wedding-band singers, who once dreamt of being a rock star. But his contentment with life shatters when his fiancée stands him up at the altar. After wallowing in self-pity and swearing off women, he helps a new friend, Julia get ready for her impending nuptials only to find himself falling in love with her.



Cromwell (DVD)

Richard Harris and Sir Alec Guinness star in this sweeping, handsomely-mounted epic drama recounting the battle which raged between the monarchy and a commoner over the very soul of Great Britain. In 17th-century England, ambitious country gentleman Oliver Cromwell dared to challenge the political oppression and corruption which besieged his nation. Watching his power being usurped by a commoner, King Charles I to challenge his adversary. One man will become absolute ruler; the other will be executed. Rousing battle sequences, excellent lead and supporting performances from Robert Morley, Dorothy Tutin and Timothy Dalton, Academy Award-winning costume design and spectacular photography by renowned cinematographer Geoffrey Unsworth (Cabaret, Tess), make CROMWELL an outstanding historical drama in the tradition of Braveheart.



Lone Survivor (DVD)

Based on The New York Times bestselling true story of heroism, courage and resilience, Lone Survivor tells the incredible tale of four Navy SEALs on a covert mission to neutralise a high-level al-Qaeda operative who are ambushed by the enemy in the mountains of Afghanistan. Faced with an impossible moral decision, the small band is isolated from help and surrounded by a much larger force of Taliban ready for war. As they confront unthinkable odds together, the four men find reserves of strength and bravery as they stay in the fight to the finish.

Mark Wahlberg leads the cast as Marcus Luttrell, the author of the first-person memoir "Lone Survivor," whose book has become a motivational resource for its lessons on how the power of the human spirit is tested when we are pushed beyond our mental and physical limits.

Starring alongside Wahlberg as the other members of the elite team who gave everything for their brothers-in-arms are Taylor Kitsch as Michael Murphy, Emile Hirsch as Danny Dietz and Ben Foster as Matthew "Axe" Axelson. Eric Bana joins the core team as Erik Kristensen, their commanding officer in Afghanistan.
