

Diagram 2: Position of Proposed Container





Diagram 2: Container showing proposed roof

POLICY CONSIDERATION

The application was assessed against the Policy on Siting and Use of Containers (Appendix / Policy 6 of the LDCP)

OFFICER'S ASSESSMENT

The Policy on Siting of Containers considers the location, use and the effect on the visual amenity of the area. The container will be sited within 100m of the existing animal pens and in an area that is primarily garden land with open land and Polytunnel farming.

The proposal for a dual pitched roof to cover and protect the container creates a coherence with surrounding buildings and is in accordance with the container policy.

A condition has also been added to ensure roof water is piped to a storage tank.

The container will be used for storage of items and equipment relevant to the current farming operation carried out by Prison staff and inmates, which means the use will not adversely impact the amenity of the surrounding development.
