The proposed development site is at the General Hospital, Jamestown, where the plot is designated within the Intermediate Zone and Jamestown Historic Conservation Area.



PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

The request is to install eight thermal solar panels on the north facing roof of the General Hospital. The necessity to improve the existing Hospital hot water system requires the need to utilise renewal energy system to aid running costs. The system will have no water storage tanks visible on the roof and the flat collectors will be position at the same rate as the existing roof gradient.
