## FOR

#### AN ORDINANCE

to amend the Prisons Ordinance, 1960, to repeal and substitute section 4; and for connected and incidental purposes.

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

## Short title, commencement and interpretation

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022.

## Amendment of section 4 - Officers

2. The Prisons Ordinance, 1960 is amended by repealing section 4 and substituting the following section—

## "Officers

- 4. (1) The Governor may appoint a Superintendent of Prisons and other prison officers to execute duties in connection with any prison.
- (2) A prison officer, while on duty and as necessary for the performance of the duties of a prison officer, has the authority and responsibility of a police officer pursuant to section 17 of the Police Service Ordinance, 1975 but is not subject to the disciplinary regulations applicable to a member of the police service and is subject only to rules made in accordance with section 6.".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

This Ordinance would amend section 4 of the Prisons Ordinance, 1960 so that a prison officer no longer needs to be appointed as a police officer to perform the duties of a prison officer.
