Biography

Christine Scipio was appointed Minister for Environment, Natural Resources and Planning and Member of the Executive Council in November 2021 following the General Election on 13 October 2021.

Political Career

Christine was first elected to serve as a Member of the Legislative Council in October 2012 during a Bye Election and retained her seat during the General Elections held in 2013, 2017 and 2021.

She has served as Chairman of the Education Committee and Member of several Council Committees before the introduction of the current Ministerial system in October 2021.

As an elected Member, Christine also served as a member of the Safeguarding of Children Board, Scholarship Awards Committee, British Islands and Mediterranean Region Commonwealth Women Parliamentarian Steering Committee and the Advisory Committee on the Prerogative Mercy.

Prior to becoming a politician, Christine was employed as a Teacher in the St Helena Public Service and has also worked in Finance and Administration in both the Public Service and Private Sector
