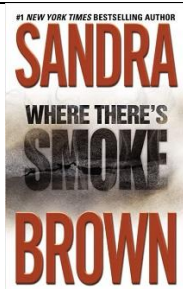


The Guest Book by C L Pattison

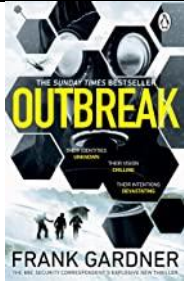


Where There's Smoke by Sandra Brown

The explosive new thriller featuring MI6 operative Luke Carlton on his most terrifying mission yet.

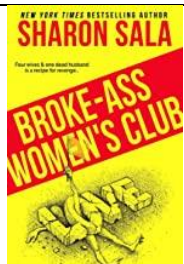
Deep within the Arctic Circle, three scientists from the UK's Arctic Research Station trudge through a blizzard in search of shelter.

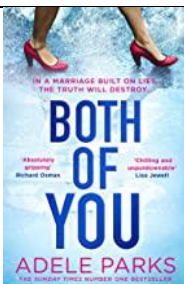


Broke-Ass Women's Club by Sharon Sala

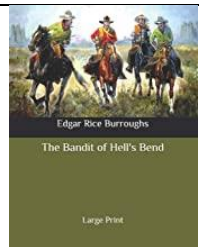
Massacre At Crow Creek Crossing by Charles G West

The Bandit of Hell's Bend by Edgar Rice Burroughs

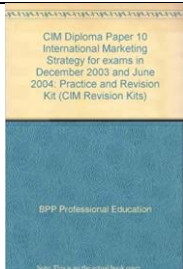

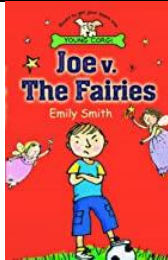
Too Small a World by Vera Milton Smith

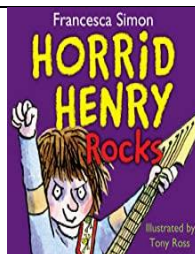

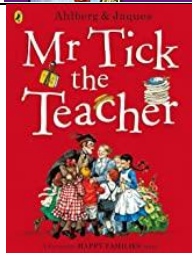
Joe V. The Fairies by Emily Smith

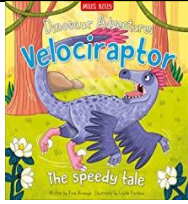
Mr Tick the Teacher by Ahlberg and Jaques
