
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B. PLANNING OFFICER'S APPRAISAL

OFFICER'S ASSESSMENT

The bin enclosure is in a residential area where you would normally expect to see infrastructure associated with solid waste collection (e.g bin stores and wheelie bins etc).

The bin enclosure is set back from the roadside and is a significant visual improvement compared to the previous arrangement of individual bins being left on the road for collection.

The development complies with the Intermediate Zone Policies in terms of siting, scale, layout, proportion, details and external materials and does not materially damage the amenity of any existing development.
