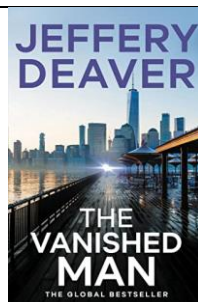
The Life She Wants by J.M.Hewitt

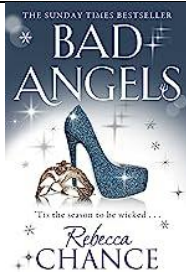
Say Goodbye by Karen Rose

But DJ Belmont has his own plan, and is not going to stop until he gets what he wants.



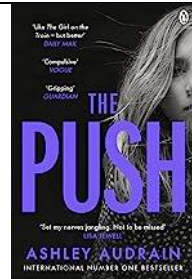
Bad Angels by Rebecca Chance
