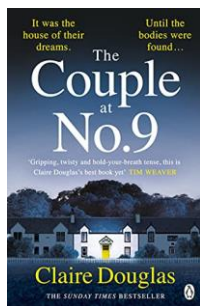

Everyone was ready for a night of trick-or-treating. Now the unthinkable has happened.

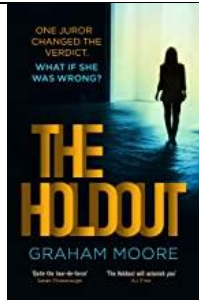
Truth or lies?

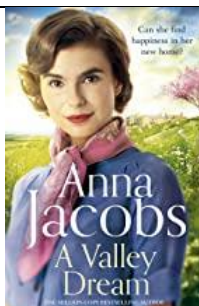
Yet the missing pieces of that fateful summer night are beginning to surface.

She can't remember. She mustn't.






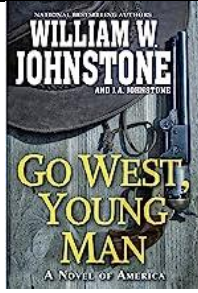
A Valley Dream by Anna Jacobs

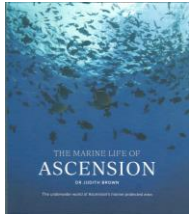
	<p>new friends help her rid herself of her tormenter once and for all and finally achieve her valley dream?</p>

Go West, Young Man by William W Johnstone

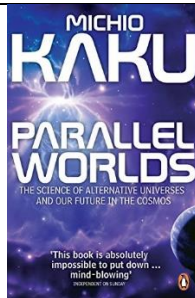

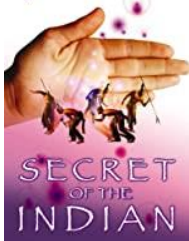
Parallel Worlds by Michio Kaku

Michio Kaku's thrilling guide to the galaxy shows us how it could happen sooner than we think - and the future for intelligent life is one of endless possibilities.

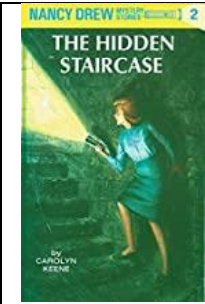


Rambo (DVD)

Since helping the mujahedeen rid Afghanistan of the Russians, John Rambo (Stallone) has been living a quiet life in northern Thailand, trapping poisonous snakes to sell to local entertainers. But when a group of human rights missionaries pleads with him to ferry them upstream to Burma to re-supply the oppressed Karen tribe, Rambo reluctantly agrees. A few weeks later however, word filters through that the missionaries have been taken hostage by the Burmese military, who are using them as pawns in their local war.
