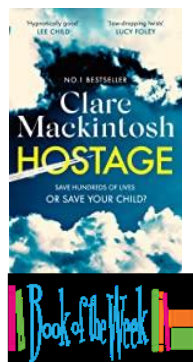

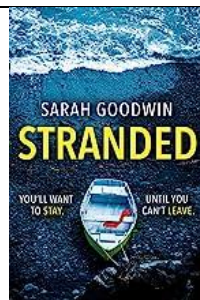

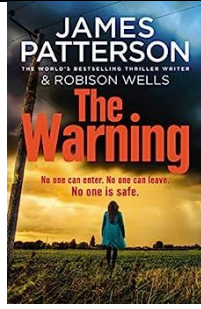
### Stranded by Sarah Goodwin

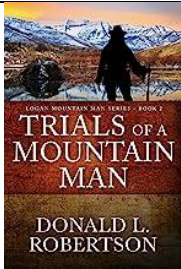


### **The Warning by James Patterson**

Something is horribly wrong, and their determination to uncover the truth soon has Maggie and Jordan in the crosshairs of a force more sinister than any they could have imagined.



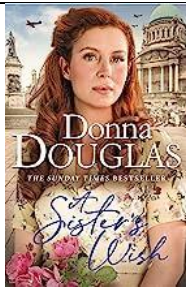
### **Trials of a Mountain Man by Donald L. Robertson**

### **A Sister's Wish by Donna Douglas**

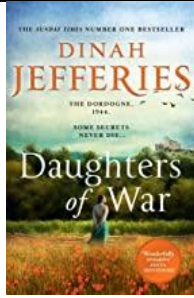

And Florence, the dreamer, just yearns for a world where France is free.

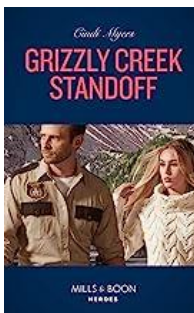

She's a small-town cop after a killer

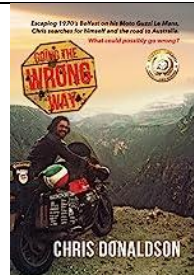

### **Grizzly Creek Standoff by Cindi Myers (2 Books in One)**

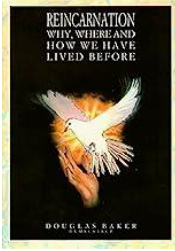
When her daughter's threatened, she fights back.

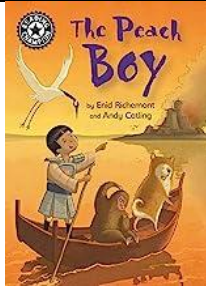


### **Creep World It Came From The Attic by Luther Darkmore**

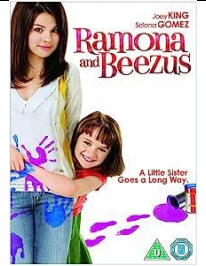

If you are looking for creepy spooky stories to read at night in bed, Creep World books are perfect for you.



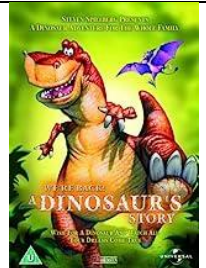
### **The Peach Boy by Enid Richmond and Andy Catling**
