The Boarding House by Sharon Sala

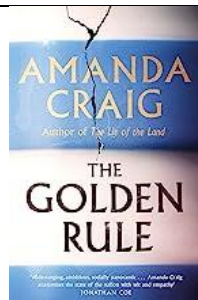
Ellie Wayne doesn't just live. She survives.

One amazing man might be the miracle worker who can help Ellie see that she has the power to move on with her life, to hope for something more. If she can trust him.

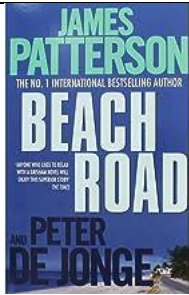
Readers will cheer for this amazing woman as she struggles to leave victimhood behind.

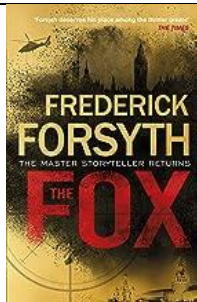


Beach Road by James Patterson

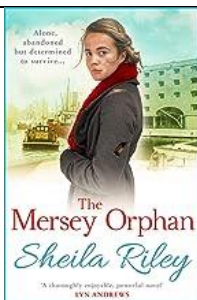
The Fox by Frederick Forsyth

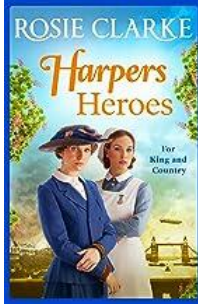
The Mersey Orphan by Sheila Riley

Oxford Street, London 1915

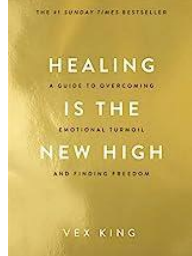
Sally Harper quietly battles to keep Harpers afloat in the difficult days of the war, whilst husband Ben is working all hours for the War Office.

A heart-warming saga following the lives, loves and losses of the Harpers Girls.



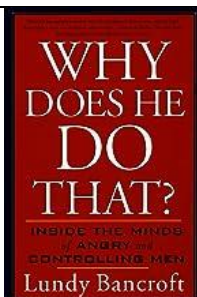

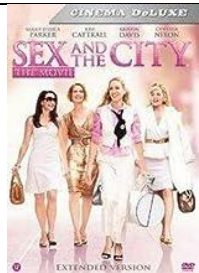
Vertical Limit (DVD)
