ST HELENA

PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

NOTICE PROHIBITING THE LANDING OR IMPORTATION OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS ORIGINATING FROM SOUTH AFRICA

As a consequence of an outbreak of avian influenza in South Africa and to prevent the introduction of the disease into St Helena, in exercise of the power conferred on the Governor of St Helena by section 55(1) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, I Nigel Phillips CBE, Governor of St Helena, hereby give notice that the landing or importation into St Helena of the undernoted products by air is prohibited with effect from 23rd October 2023 and by sea with effect immediately following the departure from St Helena of the vessel Maria da Paz on Voyage 5:

the following products originating, produced or packaged in South Africa:

- (a) all live poultry;
- (b) all birds eggs whether entire or without the shell;
- (c) all raw meat of all bird species;
- (d) all raw offal of all bird species.

And take notice that pursuant to section 55(2) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, any person who contravenes this notice commits an offence and is liable to prosecution.

This notice replaces the previous notice published in Extraordinary Gazette No 56 on 12th October 2023.
