

Instrument reassigning Ministerial responsibilities

WHEREAS it is provided in section 37D(1)(c) of the Constitution set out in Chapter 1 of the Schedule to the St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Constitution Order, 2009 that the Governor shall, on the recommendation of the Chief Minister in accordance with section 37B(1), by -instrument under the Public Seal assign or reassign the finance portfolio or other portfolios allocated to any Minister.



Chapter 1

ST HELENA



Instrument, appointing GREGORY CHARLES ROLAND GIBSON, to be Governor's Deputy.

WHEREAS it is provided in section 28(1) of the Constitution of St Helena, set out in Chapter 1 of the Schedule to the St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Constitution Order 2009, that whenever the Governor is suffering from an illness that he or she has reason to believe will be of short duration, the Governor may, by instrument under the public seal, appoint any person in St Helena to be his or her Deputy during such absence or illness and in that capacity to discharge on the Governor's behalf during such absence or illness such of the functions of the office of Governor as may be specified in that instrument.

AND WHEREAS I Nigel Phillips, Governor of St Helena am suffering from an illness that I have reason to believe will be of short duration.

NOW THEREFORE, I Nigel Phillips, Governor of St Helena, hereby appoint Gregory Charles Roland Gibson, Head of Governor's Office to be my Deputy during the period of such illness from 20 September 2023 until such time as I am able to return to office, and in that capacity to discharge on my behalf all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor (save the power of pardon) as, but no more than, he may from time to time deem to be necessary for the peace, order and good government of St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha.
