




#### Killing Time by Stephen Leather

Now they are ending their days in a dismal nursing home in Blackpool, with only their memories to keep them going. Memories of murder and mutilation.



So they set up a business of their own: organising stylish and perfectly affordable vintage weddings.


Soon they are busy arranging other people's Big Days. What none of them know is that their own romances are waiting just around the corner.



#### Soul Surfer by Bethany Hamilton


In this moving personal account of faith and fortitude, internationally ranked surfer Bethany Hamilton tells how she survived a shark attack that cost her arm but not her spirit. They say Bethany Hamilton has saltwater in her veins. How else could one explain the passion that drives her to surf? How else could one explain that nothing not even the loss of her arm could come between her and the waves? That Halloween morning in Kauai, Hawaii, Bethany responded to the shark's stealth attack with the calm of a girl with God on her side. Pushing pain and panic aside, she began to paddle with one arm, focusing on a single thought: "Get to the beach...."

And when the first thing Bethany wanted to know after surgery was "When can I surf again?" it became clear that her spirit and determination were part of a greater story a tale of courage and faith that this soft-spoken girl would come to share with the world. 
#### Namibia by Lizzie Williams


#### How to be a Gardener back to basics by Alan Titchmarsh


How to be a Gardener Book One, available at long last in paperback, is the fastest-selling gardening book of all time with sales in excess of 600,000 copies.


#### Napoleon and Saint Helena Volume 1 by Michel Dancoisne-Martineau


The importance Napoleon gave to the island of St Helena during his years in power as First Consul and then as Emperor of the French is the unexplored history we discover in this first volume "Napoleon and St Helena, 1800 – October 15<sup>th</sup>, 1815.

We become acquainted with St Helena's importance during the Dutch occupation of the Cape Province and its strategic significance for the East India Company. We learn about the details of the visits of the Governor general of the East Indies and his brother, the Duke of Wellington, and we find out about the first call to St Helena of Admiral Cockburn in 1805 and the full account of his return to the island in 1815 with his famous prisoner, Napoleon.

#### Arthur's Reading Race by Marc Brown




#### Salmon Fishing in the Yemen (DVD)

#### Water for Elephants (DVD)


