The St Helena Pets and Livestock Return 2024

A census of animals on St Helena is now due.

Under section 7 of the Agriculture and Livestock Improvement Ordinance, 1940, read with section 12A of the Dogs and Cats Ordinance, 2011, all persons owning or having in their possession any cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, donkeys, poultry, dogs and cats are required to complete a Return. This Return must be provided in respect of all pets and livestock owned or kept on **Wednesday 10 January 2024** for each member of the household who is the principal owner or keeper.

Under the current law the Return is a legally enforced obligation, as the statistics so provided assist with the planning and assessment of agricultural policies designed to increase the productivity of the island. The census also includes dogs and cats as they too impact on different aspects of the island's environment.

Forms should be completed by **Wednesday 17 January 2024**. Failure to provide a Return can result in a fine on conviction of up to £100 for every day overdue. Please note that those who do not own or care for any animals should not fill in a return. Forms will be delivered in January by enumerators acting on behalf of the Environment, Natural Resources and Planning Portfolio, and will also subsequently be collected by the Enumerators.

Advice on how to fill in the form is included in the form. Additional advice can be sought from the Enumerator, or the Veterinary Section at Environment, Natural Resources and Planning Portfolio on 24724.
