Can the Chief Minister tell this House, if there would be any enhanced benefits for St Helena in respect of developing the island's infrastructure now that a New Joint Declaration has been agreed by the UK Government and elected leaders of the British Overseas Territories?

Will the Honourable Minister state what are the current and proposed components of the development plan to establish an enabling environment for private sector development to which the Honourable Chief Minister alluded in her Christmas message?
