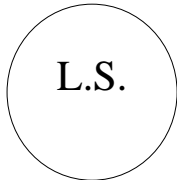

CURRENCY (ASCENSION) ORDINANCE, 2009

PROCLAMATION

In the Name of His Majesty Charles III, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and His other Realms and Territories King, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

WHEREAS it is fitting that coins to commemorate the 20th Anniversary of Concorde's Last Flight designs should be issued under the provisions of section 4(1) of the Currency (Ascension) Ordinance, 2009, which said coins shall be legal tender in Ascension.

AND WHEREAS it is within the province of the Governor to specify the denomination, weight, form and design and composition of coins to be made and issued, by Proclamation and with the approval of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE, I, the Governor of Ascension, acting in accordance with the provisions of section 4(2) of the Ordinance, and with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby order and specify for Ascension the following coins:

This five-coin series will be released in celebration of the 20th anniversary of the last flight of Concorde, which took place on 24th October 2003.

Design 1 – Quarter Sovereign – Features the Mach meter from Concorde's flight deck showing Mach speed, with a 'Concorde 20' symbol.

Design 2 – Half Sovereign – Features the Artificial Horizon Meter showing the pilot of Concorde its pitch compared to the horizon, with a 'Concorde 20' symbol.

Design 3 – Sovereign – Features the Altimeter showing Concorde's cruising height, with a 'Concorde 20' symbol.

Design 4 – Double Sovereign – Features a plan view of the front half of Concorde with a quote about its remarkable status, overlaid on a map of the region in which it flew, with a 'Concorde 20' symbol.

Design 5 – Five Pounds – Features a plan view of the rear half of Concorde with details of the last commercial flight, overlaid on a map, with a 'Concorde 20' symbol.

Obverse Design – Portrait of His Majesty King Charles III. Created by renowned numismatic artist Jody Clark.

The King's Portrait side of the coin shall be dated 2023.
