Can the Honorable Chief Minister tell this Council what progress has been made towards progressing the draft Succession Policy and associated plans for key positions, now that the COVID pandemic is behind us?

The Hon Ronald Coleman:

Can the Honorable Chief Minister say what is considered to be the complementary policies that is not directly related to employment but substantially impact St Helena's ability to deliver the vision of this Labour Market Strategy?

The Hon Dr Corinda Essex:

Can the Honorable Chief Minister say what were the key outcomes of the St Helena Government pay and allowances review that was in progress in September 2021 to identify and address factors that lead to real and perceived inequities in compensation?

The Hon Robert Midwinter:

Can the Honourable Chief Minister tell this Council what medium to long term strategies have been developed by her government, in order to assist individuals with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities in achieving their maximum potential, and ensure that inclusion is normalised in the workplace?

The Hon Karl Thrower:

Could the Chief Minister inform this House how important the government considers the document, Labour Market Strategy: 2020 – 2035 when making policy decisions and implementing the Minister's Vision?

Can the Honorable Chief Minister say how has the implementation of Career Access St Helena (CASH) and the establishment of the HR Community of Practice, as referred to in the LMS, contributed to the effectiveness of workforce development on St Helena?
