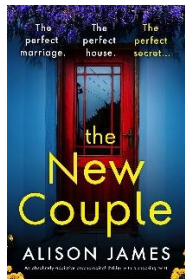

The New Couple by Alison James

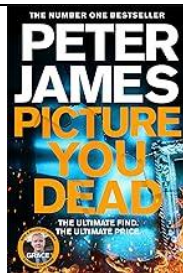

And I'm not Stephanie Hamlin.



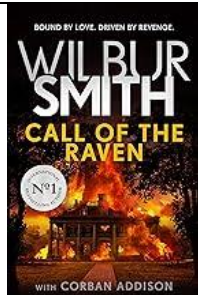
Picture You Dead by Peter James

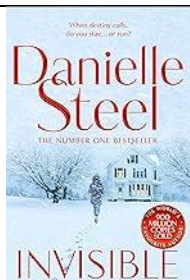


Call of the Raven by Wilbur Smith

As Mungo battles his own fate and misfortune, he must question what it takes for a man to regain his power in the world when he has nothing, and what he is willing to do to exact revenge.



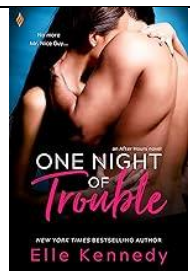
Invisible by Danielle Steel

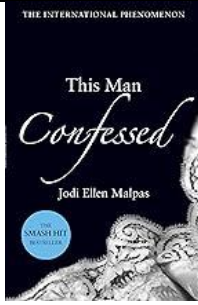

Can she snare that true love's first kiss or is she royally screwed?



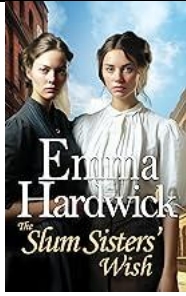
Something to Tell You by Lucy Diamond

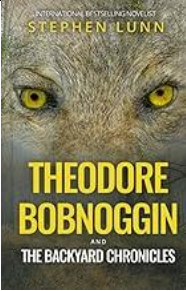


The Slum Sisters Wish by Emma Hardwick

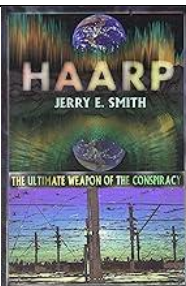

But what if the mistake is actually the first clue to discovering who Sophie and Agatha really are?

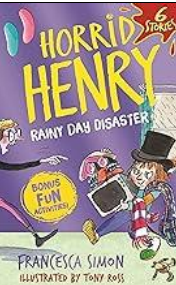


Skandar and the Phantom Rider by A F Steadman

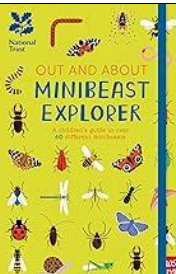

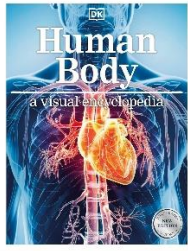


Out and About Mini beast Explorer by Robin Swift
