Will the Honourable Minister for Safety, Security and Home Affairs tell this Council what progress has been made for the provision of a project to provide maintenance and improvements to our road networks?

The Hon Dr Corinda Essex:

Will the Honourable Minister for Safety, Security and Home Affairs please state what level of priority St Helena Government attaches to construction of a new prison and explain why works have not yet commenced?

The Hon Robert Midwinter:

Can the Honourable Minister tell this Council what consideration has been given to ensuring that persons with disabilities will be able to fully access all of the amenities being developed within the Rupert's Port area?

The Hon Karl Thrower:

Will the Honourable Minister tell this Council, what specific infrastructure improvements are planned to accommodate the changes in traffic patterns due to the new port facility and to mitigate any potential increase to congestion in Jamestown, especially on Napoleon Street and the surrounding area?
