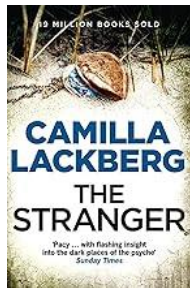

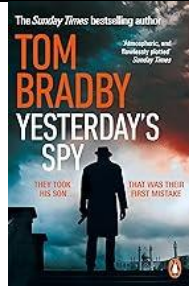


### **The Stranger by Camilla Lackberg**

### **Yesterday's Spy by Tom Brabdy**

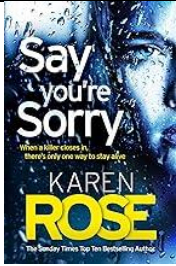
A man in search of his son. An agent on the run from his past. A country on the verge of revolution.

Before long, he is on the run - not only from a faceless enemy, but from his own past. Which will catch up with him first?

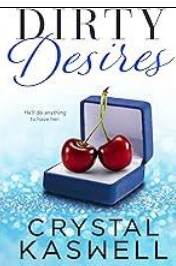


### **Say You're Sorry by Karen Rose**

Six figures. Thirty days. Every one of her firsts.

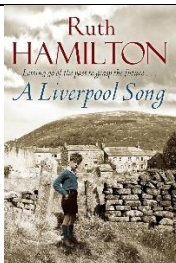
Eve Miller is screwed. Between rent and her family's medical debts, she's drowning. She needs money, now, or she's going to lose her sister.

### **A Liverpool Song by Ruth Hamilton**

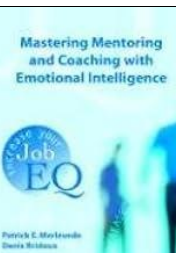
Letting go of the past to grasp the future.

At Andrew's time of life, is this really what he needs? One thing is sure, home is a lot more interesting than it once was.

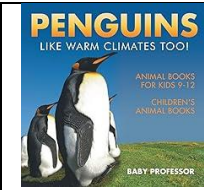
