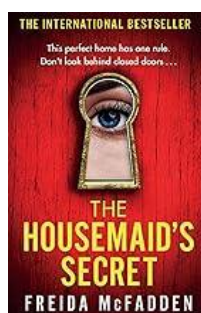

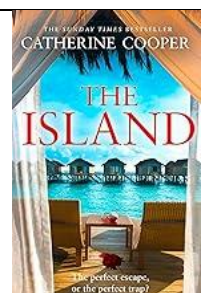

The Island by Catherine Cooper

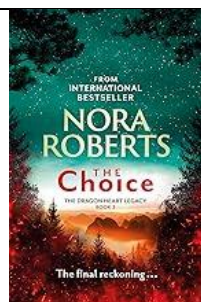
The perfect escape, or the perfect trap?

Are the guests really who they seem to be, or does each one of them have a secret to hide?










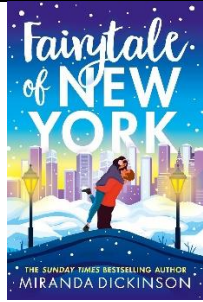
The Choice by Nora Roberts

Fairytale of New York by Miranda Dickinson

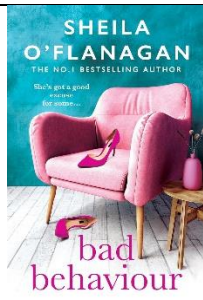
Once upon a time an English girl went to New York to live out her very own fairytale.

Bad Behaviour by Sheila O'Flanagan

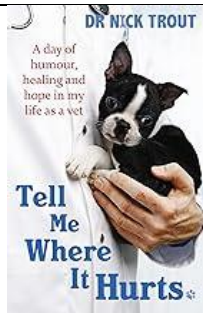
Darcey and Nieve were best friends - until Nieve stole Aidan, the boy Darcey had fallen in love with while Nieve was travelling.

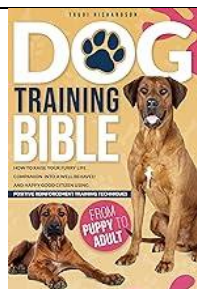
Will Darcey be there? Will there be fireworks? And can the past be put to rest at last?
