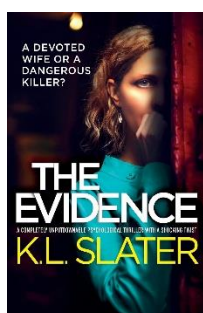

The Evidence by K.L. Slater

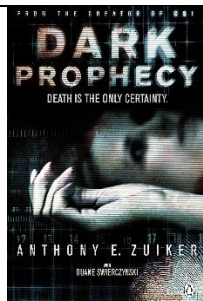
I can see her through the glass door. She's smaller in real life than I expected. She looks the exact opposite of the type of woman that might murder her husband.

Dark Prophecy by Anthony E. Zuiker

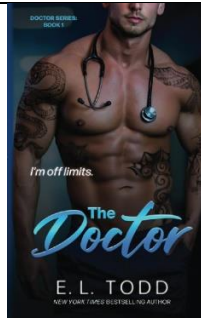
Steve Dark is a man on a mission. He is ready to embrace his destiny, and has nothing to lose.

After five years together, he realized he was gay.

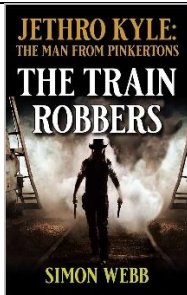
Once the anger had faded away, there was nothing but love behind. This man is still my best friend and I want him in my life.

And he's NOTHING like his brother.

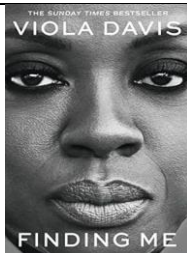

Finding Me by Viola Davis






In my book, you will meet a little girl named Viola who ran from her past until she made a life changing decision to stop running forever.



