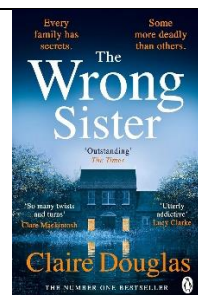


The Mother by T.M. Logan

Or do you stop at nothing to find out the truth about what really happened that night and to get your family back?



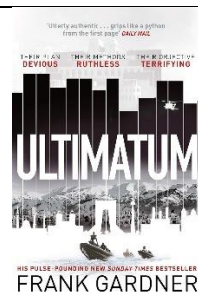
The Wrong Sister by Claire Douglas





Hidden from prying Western satellites, Iranian scientists are at work on a banned device.



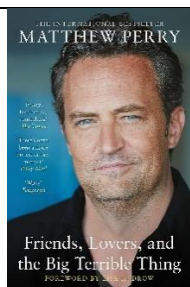

After nearly two years separated, she is elated that for once, time is on their side, and she immediately says yes when Atlas asks her on a date.</p> <p>But her excitement is quickly hampered by the knowledge that, though they are no longer married, Ryle is still very much a part of her life and Atlas Corrigan is the one man he will hate being in his ex-wife and daughter's life.</p> <p>Switching between the perspectives of Lily and Atlas, It Starts with Us picks up right where the epilogue for the bestselling phenomenon It Ends with Us left off.</p>

	<p><u>Mad About You by Mhairi McFarlane</u></p> <p>Two strangers. One big coincidence. Driving each other crazy is just the beginning Harriet Hatley is running away from everything. Getting married. Her boyfriend's family. Her past. A dream house-share seems like the perfect place to hide, but her unlikely housemate Cal is no stranger to running away himself. And he's also hiding secrets of his own. Can these two take a crazy risk, face the past and finally find a reason to stay?</p>
	<p><u>Lancashire Legacy by Anna Jacobs</u></p> <p>At eighteen, Cathie longs for more than life as a settler in the Australian bush. So when her uncle offers her the chance to send her to England, she grabs the opportunity with both hands and runs away from her family. But little does she know that he is using her to get revenge on his sister, Liza. Attacked at the docks in Liverpool, Cathie takes refuge with the man who saved her, a man who has his own troubles. But as she slowly regains her memory and meets her Lancashire relatives, she must confront the legacy of her mother's past. And even in 1876, the same wealthy families who forced her mother to leave Lancashire are still powerful enough to threaten Cathie's happiness and safety as well as that of anyone close to her.</p>
	<p><u>Daughter of the Tide by Leah Fleming</u></p> <p>It is 1939 and the eve of the Second World War when the handsome sailor Ewan Mackinnon returns to his childhood home on the remote Hebridean island of Phetray. Arriving home, many years later, he is reunited with Minn Macfee, a cottar's daughter, instantly falling for her graceful beauty and enchanting voice. But Minn and Ewan are bound by the same misfortune that caused their separation in childhood. When Ewan joins the Special Boat Squadron and embarks for France, leaving Minn behind, it seems fate has intervened once more. 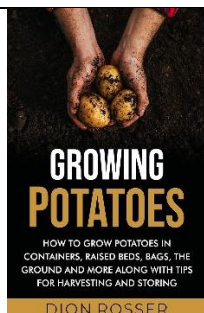


Friends, Lovers, and the Big Terrible Thing by Matthew Perry

Hi, my name is Matthew, although you may know me by my full name. My friends call me Matty.'

In an extraordinary story that only he could tell - and in the heartfelt, hilarious, and warmly familiar way only he could tell it - Matthew Perry lays bare the fractured family that raised him (and also left him to his own devices), the desire for recognition that drove him to fame, and the void inside him that could not be filled even by his greatest dreams coming true. But he also details the peace he's found in sobriety and how he feels about the ubiquity of Friends, sharing stories about his cast mates and other stars he met along the way. Frank, self-aware, and with his trademark humour, Perry vividly depicts his lifelong battle with addiction and what fuelled it despite seemingly having it all.

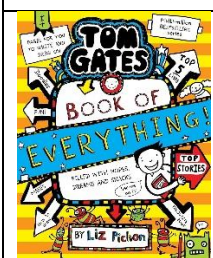

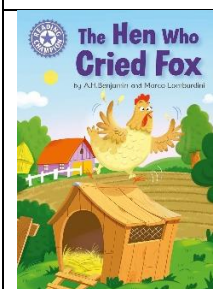
Beast Quest Lupix The Ice Wolf by Adam Blade

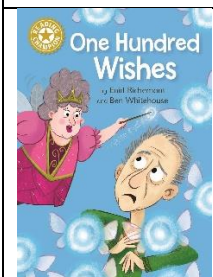
Tom Gates Book of Everything by Liz Pichon

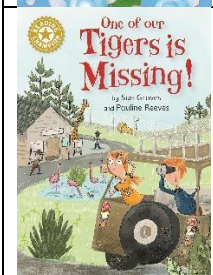
The Hen Who Cried Fox by A H Benjamin and Marco Lombardini
