materials which requires the use of standard carpentry tools and carpentry bench machinery. Install and repair water, heating and

drainage systems.

#### JOB OUTLINE:

- Construct, repair, restore and install structures, such as floors, doors, walls, windows/frames, stairways, fitted furniture, cabinets, skirting boards cupboards, shelving and roofs.
- Operate and perform preventative maintenance on hand and power saws, planers, joiners, shapers and a variety of hand tools.
- Install, repair and maintain pipes, fixtures and other plumbing equipment used for water distribution and waster water disposal in residential and commercial buildings.
- Estimate materials/time needed for assigned work projects.
- Assess work to be undertaken for quality and value.
- Erect scaffolding and ladders for assembling structures above ground level.
- Be responsible for the general cleaning of equipment, workshop and work site area.
- Any other related duties as required by Management.

- Be in possession of a valid driver's licence
- Be competent in English and Maths
