AN ORDINANCE

to provide for the services of Ascension Island for the financial year 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026

Enacted by the Governor of Ascension after consultation with the Island Council of Ascension.

Short title and commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance 2025, and comes into force on 1 April 2025.

Consolidated Fund – provision for the financial year 2025-26

2. The Governor may cause to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund and applied to the services of the financial year which commences on 1 April 2025 a sum not exceeding £8,391,386 (Eight Million, Three Hundred and Ninety-One Thousand, three Hundred and Eighty-Six Pounds) which is appropriated for the purposes and services described in the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Development Fund - provision for the financial year 2025-26

- 3. (1) The Governor may cause to be issued out of the Development Fund and applied to the services of the financial year which commences on 1 April 2025 a sum not exceeding £240,355 (Two Hundred and Forty Thousand, Three Hundred and Fifty-Five Pounds) which is appropriated for Development Fund expenditure as described in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
 - (2) Insofar as those sums are not expended in 2025-26 any balances may be carried forward to 2026-27 or redirected in either financial year to any of the projects specified in the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This explanatory note does not form part of the Ordinance)

This Ordinance, in compliance with section 167 of the Constitution, authorises the Government to make withdrawals from the Consolidated Fund and the Development Fund for the financial year 2025-2026 in the amounts set out therein and for the purposes identified in the Schedule. Depreciation charges have been removed from the Schedules as these are non-cash adjustments.

Consolidated Fund appropriation is agreed on the assumption cash revenues will be raised to the value of £7,215,650 (Seven Million, two hundred and Fifteen Thousand, Six Hundred and Fifty Pounds), with a net cash deficit for the year of £1,175,736 (One Million, One Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and Thirty-Six Pounds).
