### **ISLAND GOVERNMENT (ASCENSION) ORDINANCE, 2008**

### **NOTICE OF SECOND FURTHER GENERAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS notice was given for the Island Council to be dissolved with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> April 2025;

AND WHEREAS notice was given for a Further General Election to be held on Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025 and that nominations had to be received by the Returning Officer at the Administration Office in Georgetown by Thursday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2025;

AND WHEREAS insufficient valid nominations were received and the Returning Officer declared the election to be void and provided notice of such to the Administrator as required by regulation 7(2) of the Elections Regulations, 2008;

AND WHEREAS section 8(2) of the Island Government (Ascension) Ordinance, 2008, provides that if the number of candidates duly nominated for election at a general election is fewer than six, the provisions of the Ordinance stand suspended, except for the purposes of holding a further general election, until such time as a new Council of at least five members is duly elected;

AND WHEREAS section 8(3) of the Ordinance further provides that if the operation of the Ordinance stands suspended, the Governor must call a new general election within six months of the date on which section 8(2) took effect;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Nigel Phillips CBE, Governor, do hereby give notice that the Second Further General Election is to be held on Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2025. I further give notice that the date by which nominations must be received by the Returning Officer at the Administration Office in Georgetown is Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> June 2025 by 16:30.
