

The Second Husband by Louise Candlish





Then the telegram arrives.




Remembrance Day by Leah Fleming

There's no way I'll fall for Wyatt Hennington.


He can keep his Southern drawl, irresistible smile, and those pickup lines all to himself.

John Tailer Bishop and his wife, Angelina, find themselves in the middle of a political conspiracy to prevent Senator Willis Richmond from running for president.


When the senator's daughter, Marcy, and her fiancé, Wesley Dowd, are kidnapped as part of the conspiracy, Bishop has to get involved.




A Small Person Far Away by Judith Kerr

We've added 13 new levels to our treehouse – it used to be 117 storeys, but it keeps on growing!


