






Hideaway by Nora Roberts

What happened that night may always haunt Caitlyn but she must decide if it's what you're running from that matters. Or who finds you.




A Fatal Crossing by Tom Hindle


Birch agrees to investigate, and the trail quickly leads to the theft of a priceless painting. Its very existence is known only to its owner and the now dead man.




First Strike by Stephen Leather


And as White embarks on a vengeance-driven killing spree, Shepherd is the only man who can stop him.




The Ops Room Girls by Vicki Beeby






Mrs Porter Calling by A J Pearce







Bombs On Aunt Dainty by Judith Kerr








The Dinosaur Bone by Elizabeth Dale and Stu McLellan
