

## **CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE 1999**

### CUSTOMS (MISCELLANEOUS FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Customs and Excise Ordinance 1999, the Governor on the advice of the Executive Council makes the following Regulations.

#### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Miscellaneous Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.

#### Amendment of the Customs (Miscellaneous Fees) Regulations 2006

- 2. (1) The Customs (Miscellaneous Fees) Regulations 2006 are amended as follows.

### FEES FOR ATTENDANCE OF CUSTOMS OFFICERS

The fees stated in this schedule are the fees payable per Customs Officer in attendance.

A. On a Sunday or Public Holiday For the first three hours or part thereof £45.00 **HB 68** No.21 Customs and Excise (Tariffs and Exemptions)(Amendment) Regulations 2025

For each hour (or part thereof) after the first three hours £15.00

B. At all other times
For the first three hours or part thereof
For each hour (or part thereof) after the first three hours
£10.00".

These Regulations amend the Customs (Miscellaneous Fees) Regulations 2006 by increasing the amount payable for the attendance of a Customs Officer. The amendment also clarifies that the fee is chargeable per Customs Officer in attendance.
