



Without a Trace by Lesley Pearse


Coronation Day, 1953.

She has given up everything - her home, happiness and a chance at love - all to find Petal. But is she also risking her life?




Payback in Death by J.D.Robb




In Too Deep by Lee Child

His captors assume Reacher was the driver's accomplice and patch up his wounds as they plan to make him talk.


A plan that will backfire spectacularly.

Nathaniel Hawthorne is the epitome of the perfect man.


But 12 years older and worlds wiser, my brother's best friend doesn't long for me the way I crave him.


Our bond, once vulnerable, grows stronger by the day, but the unwritten rules of friendship stand. Yet, something feels different.

I know better than to trust him, that I should never risk my heart. But fierce passion comes at a high price.




But trouble is waiting just around the corner. As with all villages, there are tensions, ambitions and secrets.


Ruby Redfort - Take Your Last Breath by Lauren Child

Kylian MBappe by Harry Meredith


Witness the birth of a superstar. Kylian Mbappé was just 19 years old when he became the youngest football player since Brazilian legend Pelé to score at a World Cup final.


The Giant Snowball Mystery by A H Benjamin and Andy Rowland
