A mystery that threatens to tear his own family apart.




Loyalty by Martina Cole

And that's just the start of his bad luck: Penny Gower from the local stables has spotted his silver Mercedes leaving the scene of the crime. Suddenly, for Lucas, things are looking very bleak indeed. Inspector Jess Campbell is on the case, but with few leads and a new superintendent, Ian Carter, breathing down her neck, she's beginning to feel the pressure. Then another dead body is found.

The Big Four by Agatha Christie



A gripping tale full of unexpected twists and turns set amid the elegance of the Edwardian era.






Tempt Me by J Kenner






The Red Pyramid by Rick Riordan


